Emergency Response Procedures Plan for Anoka County, Minnesota

This plan provides a framework for responding to emergencies within Anoka County, Minnesota, including key contacts, local authorities, evacuation procedures, first aid and medical assistance, and how to report an incident.

3. Evacuation Procedures

Evacuation Routes and Shelters:

- Designated Evacuation Routes: Primary roads include U.S. Highways 10, 169, and State Highways 65 and 47. Local roadways and transit routes will be adjusted based on the situation.
- Evacuation Shelters:
 - Anoka High School - 3939 7th Ave N, Anoka, MN 55303
 - Coon Rapids High School - 2340 Northdale Blvd NW, Coon Rapids, MN 55433
 - Blaine City Hall - 10801 Town Square Dr NE, Blaine, MN 55449
 - Rum River Library - 4201 6th Ave, Anoka, MN 55303

Evacuation Procedure:

- Stay Informed: Follow local news, weather reports, and official social media accounts from authorities (Anoka County Emergency Management, local police/fire).
 - Follow Authorities' Instructions: Evacuations will be directed by local law enforcement or emergency management personnel. Follow their instructions carefully and promptly.
 - Secure Your Site: Secure windows and doors, unplug appliances to prevent fire hazards.
 - Leave Early: If an evacuation order is given, leave promptly to avoid traffic congestion and risks.
 - Special Needs Assistance: Contact Anoka County Emergency Management at (763) 324-5000 for evacuation assistance.
 - Stay Together: Evacuate with the team when possible.

4. First Aid and Medical Assistance and Mental Health Crisis Support

First Aid Procedures:

- Basic First Aid Kit: Keep a well-stocked first aid kit at home, work, and in your vehicle. Include bandages, antiseptics, gloves, scissors, burn cream, pain relievers, etc.

- Transport to Hospital: If safe, transport injured individuals to the nearest medical facility or wait for emergency responders.

5. How to Report an Incident

General Reporting Procedures:

- Immediate Emergency Situations: Dial 911 for life-threatening emergencies.
- Provide clear details including your location, nature of the emergency, and any potential hazards.

Report Non-Emergency Incidents:

- Notify your Project Manager or Supervisor first. They will provide further instructions.
- If health or safety-related, notify Amy Robertson (HR) or your Compliance Coordinator.
